Weapons and safety

Weapons have become harder over the years, partly because new manufacturers have entered the market, such as Goldhammer and Fake Steel. At Krigslive, weapons have always been something participants are responsible for checking themselves—and we still believe that is the right approach. A strong safety culture must be upheld by everyone.

We will not ban specific weapon manufacturers, but we hope everyone will help maintain a focus on safety within their own ranks. Remember, not everyone wears armor or padding. Therefore, we strongly encourage you to consider which weapons you bring to Krigslive. If you think your weapon is a bit hard—your opponent will too.

If we become aware of weapons at Krigslive that we believe are unsafe, we will be forced to ban their use without warning. Ultimately, this is about ensuring that everyone gets home safely.

Camp area

We remind you that all tents must have an in-game appearance, and the fabric may not be made of nylon or plastic. The same naturally applies to tarps, sunshades, and similar items.

Remember to bring strong guy lines and storm pegs for your tents. Camp placement varies, so you may be more or less exposed to wind. We have previously seen tents fly away, collapse, and poles break during storms at Krigslive, so we strongly encourage everyone to bring the necessary equipment to secure their tents against bad weather.

Waste

Waste must be sorted into four categories:

- Glass
- Metal
- “Other” waste (including plastic, cardboard, paper, organic waste)
- Take home (including furniture, all types of building materials, bigger things, batteries, pressurized containers (such as hairspray, deodorant, gas canisters), and anything else that does not fit into the three categories above)

In 2025, we received an additional bill of approximately 30,000 DKK because participants did not sort waste correctly. We must address this. This means less sorting in 2026 and therefore a larger environmental impact. It will also result in stricter inspections of waste sorting.

Mandatory documents

It is important that you read and understand our Code of Conduct and our Terms and Conditions. Both are accepted when you purchase a ticket. If we become aware of behavior that violates these rules, it may result in a ban from the LARP.

If you are participating in combat, it is also important that you familiarize yourself with—and understand—our Combat Rules.

Camp activities and plot

If you wish to create a specific plot or gimmick for Krigslive, you are very welcome to do so. If you need feedback on your idea or help coordinating, contact your general staff. You can reach your generals through the Facebook groups for the two sides.

Remember that members of the general staff cannot be “assigned”/killed. Also remember that there is an option to apply for financial support for your camp activities.

Players under 18

We remind you that all players under 18 must be assigned a “trusted person” to participate in Krigslive, and we must receive a parental/guardian consent form by email no later than April 15, otherwise participation is not possible.

If your group plans to apply for an exemption regarding the number of under-18 participants per trusted person, you must email us as soon as possible. You should not expect approval, as each case is assessed individually.
